About Us

LifeSource is a funeral home dedicated to providing our community with sustainable alternatives to traditional burial and cremation. We offer end-of-life options that leave a positive legacy and protect our planet for future generations. Life Source uses only non-toxic, sustainably sourced materials that fully break down and return to the earth.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff and Overhead

\$ 1,295

Our services include: conducting the arrangements conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains. This fee includes:

- 24/7 phone availability for initial inquiries.
- In-person or virtual arrangement conferences for planning and selecting services.
- Easy and convenient web-based portal for arranging funeral services
- Custom digital memorial page and obituary
- Assistance in completing the required forms and permits – including remains scattering permits.
- Coordinating services with death doula, crematory, cemetery, and all other third parties involved in caring for the decedent.
- It also includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs (administrative expenses, insurance, regulatory and governmental compliance, etc.)

- Carbon offsets to ensure our services remain carbon neutral.

SIMPLE PACKAGES

These are the most basic services we provide to our families (also known as “direct” or “immediate” services). These do not include the cost of a ceremony/memorial, caskets, shroud, or cemetery cost. Each package includes:

- Basic services and overhead.
- Preparation of (1) death certificate and permits. Additional certificates available at added cost.
- Pickup and transportation of the decedent to our care center.
- Coordination with local medical examiner/coroner, if required. Coroner fees are not included.
- Cleaning, preparation, and refrigerated storage – NO LIMIT.
- Dressing and casketing.
- Transportation to the disposition location – up to 25 miles. \$3
- A basic cremation container or biodegradable shroud.
- Cost of disposition – Terramation, Burial at Sea, Water Cremation, Flame Cremation.
- Does not include cemetery costs for traditional or natural burial.
- State fees
- Plastic storage container for cremated or composted remains.
- Cremated remains can be picked up at our DTLA office or mailed to you at an additional cost.
- Terramated remains will be donated to the Return Home conservation forest unless distributions to friends and family are requested. Composted remains can be shipped to you at an additional cost.
- Funeral services and memorial celebrations are available at an additional cost.

Terramation™ **\$ 6,750**

Terramation (aka “natural organic reduction” or “human composting”) is the only form of disposition that fully transforms the human body into beautiful, life-giving compost. Life Source proudly partners with Return Home in Tacoma, Washington, to provide this service to Southern California.

Once in our care, we transport you/your person to Washington, where the human body is gently transformed into compost over 60-90 days (time depends on the person's size). Terramated remains are returned to the Earth and used to manage and protect Return Home’s 8-acre conservation forest in Washington State. Upon request, composted remains can be returned to your friends and family. The price varies based on the quantity of remains being shipped.

Burial at Sea..... **\$ 4,500**

As its name suggests, you can become one with the Pacific Ocean and support the marine ecosystem with this time-honored ritual. The vessel departs from San Pedro and can accommodate up to 20 people. The round trip is approximately 2.5 hours. Free parking is available.

Direct Hydrolysis or “Aquamation” **\$ 3,750**

This process is also known as alkaline hydrolysis or “water cremation”. It uses a water and lye (potassium hydroxide) solution to break down the body’s tissues in a heated, pressurized vessel. The remaining bones are processed into a fine powder and returned to the next of kin. Remains can be stored in a permanent container, scattered at a meaningful location, or used in a memorial planting.

Direct Cremation.....

\$ 1,500

In this process, the body is reduced by flames. Once the body's tissues have been completely and reduced by the flames, the remaining bones are reduced to a fine powder and returned to the family. Remains can be stored in a permanent container or scattered at a meaningful location or used in a memorial planting. Witness Cremations are also available for those who want to be there in person for an additional cost.

Natural Burial..... **\$ 2,750**

Become one with the earth as nature intended. Green burials are performed without embalming and outer burial containers, utilizing only materials that will naturally breakdown and return to the earth. Life Source will handle the care and coordination of services required to get you/your person to their chosen cemetery. This price does not include the price of casket, outer burial containers, or cemetery costs.

Immediate Burial..... **\$ 2,750**

Life Source will handle the care and coordination of services required to get you/your person to their chosen cemetery. This price does not include embalming (if desired), casket, outer burial containers, or other cemetery costs.

LIFESOURCE MEMORIALS AND CELEBRATIONS

Scattering at Custom Location included in basic service fee..... **Free**

Is there a special place you want your remains to be spread? If it is legal and safe, Life Source will help you or your person fulfill your/their end-of-life wishes by helping you complete the necessary paperwork and secure the proper permissions.

Scatter at Sea..... **\$ 800 – 1,200**

Return to earth by releasing cremated remains into the mighty Pacific Ocean off the coast of San Pedro. Boats depart from San Pedro Marina, and the memorial trip takes approximately 1 hour 15 minutes. Free Parking is available at the marina. The costs of the scattering tubes or water urns are not included.

Memorial Tree at Better Place Forests..... **\$ 5,000 – 15,000**

Have your or your person's remains protect natural forests. Better Place owns and manages a conservation Memorial Forest in Lake Arrowhead to offer the unique experience of having your or your person's remains mixed with soil and spread at the base of a Memorial Tree and used to plant new saplings. Think of these trees as organic tombstones and the forest ecosystem as a living cemetery. Memorial trees range in price. Engraved bronze memorial plaques are available for \$500.

ITEMIZED SERVICES AND MERCHANDISE

Care and Handling

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. However, embalming may be necessary for select certain funeral arrangements, such as transport out of the United States. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as Terramation, direct cremation, or natural burial.

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home..... \$ 2,495
 Forwarding remains is the preparation and process of transferring a loved one to a funeral home out of the area. This includes basic services, transfer of the decedent to the funeral home, care and handling of the decedent, embalming (if required), and transportation to a common carrier or other funeral homes within 25 miles. (Casket, Air Tray, and carrier fees are not included.)

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home..... **\$ 1,995**
 Receiving of remains is when we receive a loved one from a funeral home out of the area. This includes our reduced basic services fee, transfer of the decedent from the common carrier to a local funeral home, sheltering, and transportation to a cemetery or crematory.
